- 1. Story Time Science** **September 26**

We'll have a bushel of science fun as we learn all about apples. From painting to tasting and graphing our investigations, we'll get to the core of apple science.
- 3. Farmyard Fun** **October 10**
Make some fun farm crafts as you learn about our own Friendly Farm. We'll churn some butter, meet a chicken, and feed the goats and sheep.
- 4. Colorful Science** **October 17**
Take a closer look at primary and secondary colors through crafts, and read a story about colorful animals.
- 5. Building Bonanza** **October 24**
From LEGO DUPLO® structures to bridges and mazes, try your hand at coordinated effort to build and create.
- 6. Halloween Hidings** **October 31**
Together we'll learn about animal coverings and their homes. A few feathered and furry friends will join us in class. Dress-up is welcome this week.
- 7. Rock Stars** **November 7**
Dig into geology as we perform simple experiments and learn how to tell rocks and minerals apart.
- 8. African Adventures** **November 15**
Jump to the beat of an African tune, listen to a folktale, and meet an animal that hails from this diverse continent. Take home an African craft to remind you of your safari.
